



## **Key Facts About Coronet Industries**

- Coronet Industries manufactures Defluorinated Phosphate, a nutritional supplement used by farmers to raise poultry, turkey, cattle, and swine.
- Coronet's Plant City facility was opened in 1906.
- Today the plant employs about 90 people and has an annual payroll and benefits that exceed \$6 million.
- The Coronet Industries plant has the capacity to manufacture 250,000 tons of Defluorinated Phosphate annually. Between 1 million and 1.5 million tons of phosphoric animal feed supplement are consumed each year in the United States.
- Coronet Industries recovers fluorine from the process of making Defluorinated Phosphate and converts it into potassium fluoroborate, or KBF 4. KBF 4 is used to make aluminum alloy commonly used in household products such as aluminum cans and aluminum foil.
- Coronet has the capacity to produce about 2,600 tons of KBF 4 annually.
- The plant operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year. The company's 980-acre site includes a 205-acre, 18-hole golf course that serves as the home to Plant City Golf Club.
